

International Travel Awards for Young Chemists – 2019

Terms and conditions of the call:

(1) Objective

The Young Chemists Division of the [Real Sociedad Española de Química \(Grupo Especializado de Jóvenes Investigadores Químicos\)](#), hereinafter, RSEQ and JIQ respectively) opens this call from January 29, 2019 to February 17, 2019 (remember that the deadline for submission of contributions –posters and oral communications– is January 30 and the deadline for early registration is March 2) to fund an exchange program with up to **five international young students & researchers** to attend the XXXVII Biennial Meeting of the RSEQ. This support is provided in collaboration with the [European Young Chemist's Network](#) (hereinafter, EYCN) to encourage the presence and interaction of young researchers across Europe and to promote the RSEQ.

(2) Applicant requirements

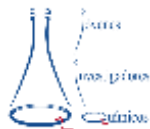
- Non-Spanish nationality, under 35 as of 30 January 2019 and conducting their research in a European country different from Spain
- Member of a Chemical Society that is part of EuChemS ([see List](#))
- Ensuring presence at the award ceremony
- Attendance at the meeting and presentation of a scientific contribution (oral or poster) is not mandatory but it is highly encouraged and prioritized.

(3) Each award consists on

500 € travel grant for transport, accommodation and registration fee ([see website](#)); if total travel costs exceed the grant, the difference must be covered by the beneficiary.

(4) Evaluation of applications

Applications received will be evaluated by the EYCN management team and a committee made up of 2-3 members of the JIQ board of directors who are not involved in the organization of the proposed activity, nor directly linked to any of the applicants.



(5) Resolution

The aid will be settled before 20 February 2019. The decision of the evaluation committee shall be final. The resolution will be published on the JIQ website, as well as in its different profiles on social networks. Interested parties will be notified via e-mail.

(6) Required Documentation

- CV (only in PDF format, 3 pages maximum)
- A signed letter for supervisor or advisor acknowledging the candidate's attendance to the meeting.
- The e-mail must contain a signed declaration in which the candidate guarantees his presence at the conference and the award ceremony in case of success.

This form will be sent, duly completed and converted to PDF format, to secretaria@jiq-rseq.es specifically in the subject line: ***International Travel Award for Young Chemists -applicant's name-***

Upon receipt of the application will confirm receipt of it, as a deadline for the correction of possible errors in the application.

(7) Obligations of awardees

If the aid is granted, and as a condition for the economic perception of it, the awardees undertake to submit, within one month after the celebration of the activity:

- **Copy of the assistance** and scientific contribution certificates.

Likewise, the awardees undertake to include and make visible the logos of the JIQ and of the RSEQ in the scientific contribution.


